Lois's Heavenly Potatoes

I'm not sure if these are called heavenly potatoes because they taste 'divine' or because if you eat too many they will shorten your life and you will go to heaven sooner than expected. -Lois

Heavenly Potatoes



Ingredients:

- 2 pounds Russet potatoes, peeled and diced
- 4 TBSP butter, melted
- ½ cup sour cream
- ¼- ½ cup milk
- ½ cup sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- ½ tsp salt
- ¼ tsp black pepper
- 1/3 cup sliced green onion
- 4 slices bacon, cooked and crumbled

Directions:

- 1.** Put diced potatoes in a large pot. Cover with water and bring to a boil over high heat. Reduce heat and simmer until potatoes are fork tender, about 15 minutes. Drain and transfer to a stand mixer fitted with a whisk attachment. Add in melted butter and beat slowly until mostly mashed. Add in sour cream, ¼ cup milk, cheese, salt, and black pepper. Continue beating until it reaches desired consistency, adding remaining ¼ cup milk if necessary. Use a rubber spatula to stir in half of the green onions and bacon,
- 2.** Transfer to a serving dish and sprinkle remaining green onions and bacon on top.
